

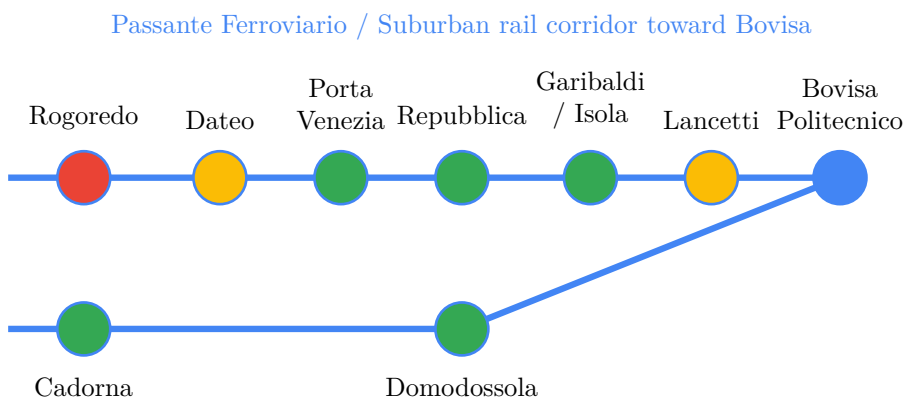
Where to Stay in Milano to Reach Politecnico Bovisa

Passante Ferroviario-Oriented Housing Zones

Goal

The most practical rule is to stay near a **Passante Ferroviario** station, especially stations with direct suburban rail access to **Milano Bovisa Politecnico**.

Simplified map of recommended zones



Well connected, many restaurants and services.



Good alternatives depending on budget and lifestyle.



Less convenient for a daily Bovisa commute.

Best macro areas to prioritize

- **Bovisa**: simplest option for reaching campus; ideal if campus proximity matters more than centrality. Limited restaurants availability.
- **Lancetti**: very convenient, usually more practical and potentially cheaper than the city center.
- **Porta Garibaldi / Isola**: excellent connection to Bovisa, restaurants, services, and metro interchanges.
- **Cadorna**: excellent connection to Bovisa, restaurants, services, and metro interchanges.

Good alternatives

- **Repubblica**: central, elegant, and well connected through the Passante.
- **Porta Venezia**: central, lively, and connected through the Passante.
- **Dateo**: good option on the eastern side of the Passante.
- **Maciachini**: decent north-side option, especially if prices near Garibaldi or Isola are too high.

- **Porta Romana:** possible, but generally less direct for Bovisa unless the exact apartment has a convenient connection.
- **Rogoredo:** connected through the Passante, but farther away; useful if you also need south/east rail access.
- **Navigli / Famagosta:** nice areas, requires commuting in Cadorna FN less efficient for daily trips to Bovisa.

Practical recommendation

For the best balance between commute and quality of life, prioritize apartments within walking distance of **Lancetti**, **Garibaldi/Isola**, **Repubblica**, **Porta Venezia**, **Dateo**, or **Bovisa**. If budget is the main constraint, look around **Lancetti**, **Bovisa**, **Dergano**, and **Affori** first.
